

2022 Wyandot County Junior Fair Exhibitor Requirements

by Friday, July 15, 2022

Entry web site opens Sunday, May 15, 2022

Junior Fair and Open Class Exhibitor Passes - Must be purchased by August 15, 2022

- ✓ A junior fair exhibitor **pass** and **completed on-line entry** are required for members to **exhibit at the fair and receive a premium.**
- ✓ Junior Fair Exhibitor passes are \$5 for youth and \$25 for advisors.
- ✓ Senior Fair Open Class exhibitor passes are \$10 for youth and \$25 for adults
 - The decision to exhibit in Open class should be made at the time of purchasing your pass.
- ✓ Only exhibitors who are in good standing and who display their project at the Fair will be eligible for a Junior Fair Exhibitor pass.
- ✓ 4-H Cloverbuds and Boy/Girl Scouts **under eight (8) years of age** by the date of the Fair are not required to have an exhibitor pass and will still be eligible to display a project in the club booth for a ribbon, but not eligible to receive a premium. An exhibitor pass, an entry form and display are required to receive a \$1 premium.
- ✓ 4-H Cloverbuds and Boy/Girl Scouts who **will be eight (8) years of age** by the date of the Fair **must** submit an exhibitor pass and entry form by August 15.
- ✓ **Passes may be picked up at the Jr. Fair Office on:**
 - Friday, September 9
 - Saturday, September 10
 - Sunday, September 11

Passes will only be given to the exhibitor or their parent/guardian unless prior arrangements are made.

On-line Entries - Junior Fair Entries are open May 15 and close Friday, July 15 and Open Class entries are open July 16 to September 1, 2022. You Must make Jr. Fair and Open Entries separately.

- ✓ An entry is required for each exhibit to be displayed at the Fair.
- ✓ Entries are to be made on-line at <https://wyandot.fairwire.com>
- ✓ A "Release of Liability" Form will be included on-line with completion of Entry.
- ✓ 4-H Youths who plan to be judged by an advisor for a participation grade must make an entry by **July 15**, and have project(s) judged and a grade sheet returned to the Ohio State University Extension office by **August 15**.

Exhibits

- ✓ **Art Projects** must be brought to the Culinary Building on Friday September 9 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. or Saturday, September 10, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. **Judging will be Saturday at 1:00 p.m.**
- ✓ **Industrial Arts** must be brought to the Culinary Building on Friday September 9 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, September 10, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. or Sunday, September 11, from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- ✓ **ALL EXHIBITS** (livestock, booths, arts, etc.) must be in place by 7:00 p.m. on Sunday September 11 and remain in place until Noon on Sunday, September 18 to receive a premium (except at the discretion of the Senior Fair).

Premiums

- ✓ **Premium checks** will be available Saturday, September 17 at the Masters' Building TBD
- ✓ Premium checks **will not be mailed.** Checks will be available until November 1, 2022 at the Senior Fair Office.
- ✓ A single premium check will be issued to each exhibitor regardless of membership in multiple organizations. An itemized listing indicating the amount earned for each project will appear below the check.
- ✓ **4-H Cloverbuds and Boy/Girl Scout premiums will be paid to the Club/Troop;** individual checks will not be issued.
