Livestock Birth Dates, Possession Dates, and Jr. Fair Classes for the 2024 Wyandot County Fair

- Interview judging will be at the discretion of the Ohio State University Extension Office.
- The premium an exhibitor receives will be based on the grade the animal receives in the show ring.

Exhibiting at the Fair

- Drug Use Notification Forms must be completed and turned in at check-in on Sunday, September 8.
- Stall space is not to be used to store hay, straw, feed, or supplies.
- Cows in milk can go home after the show except the Champion of Champion, which must remain for the week.
- The Dairy show will be held Monday, September 9 at 10:00 am.

Dairy Department Dress Code

This is a requirement for show and sale: Exhibitors must wear a white full button-up shirt (no polos), to be buttoned from bottom to at least two buttons from the collar and tucked in. Exhibitors must also wear white pants/jeans with no holes. Exhibitors will not be permitted to enter the show/sale ring without wearing appropriate attire.
