- All Feeder Calves will receive a vaccination at tag day. Cost is \$8.00 each calf. The 2nd vaccination needs to be administered by your vet between July 10 & August 15.
- Solution Strain Contracts are due **July 15th** to the Sr. Fair Office.
- Jr Fair Livestock King & Queen Application are due July 15th (Application is in packet and available online)
- Swine Production weigh-in is **Saturday**, **June 15** at fairgrounds.
- All Swine projects must turn in an affidavit for Ractopamine use at check in.
- * All Poultry projects need to turn in NPIP Hatchery papers at check in.
