- ✓ *Adult passes \$30, Youth passes \$15 (Jr. Fair passes before Aug. \$5), \$8 day passes*
- ✓ *New “Born and Raised” Rabbit classes (details online or in premium book)*
- ✓ *Market Beef showmanship and Beef Feeder showmanship will be held at the start of their shows on Thursday. Open Class Beef Show will remain on Friday*
- ✓ *All feeder calves must have a completed Drug Use Notification Form.*

- ❖ *Junior Fair Board Nomination Forms and Apprentice Forms are due **Feb. 21st at the Jr. Fair board meeting.***
- ❖ *Clubs participating in planting flower bed call office by **June 1st**. Plant by **June 15.***
- ❖ *Enter your projects online at <https://wyandot.fairwire.com> between **May 15** and **July 15, 2024.***
- ❖ *Jr Fair King & Queen Nominations are due **June 1st** to the Sr. Fair Office.*
- ❖ *All Feeder Calves, All Market Lambs & All Market Goats must be ear-tagged at the fairgrounds **Saturday, June 1st.***
- ❖ *All Feeder Calves will receive a vaccination at tag day. Cost is \$8.00 each calf. The 2nd vaccination needs to be administered by your vet between **July 10 & August 15.***
- ❖ *Jr Fair King & Queen Applications and Contracts are due **July 15th** to the Sr. Fair Office.*
- ❖ *Jr Fair Livestock King & Queen Application are due **July 15th** (Application is in packet and available online)*
- ❖ *Swine Production weigh-in is **Saturday, June 15** at fairgrounds.*
- ❖ ***All Swine projects must turn in an affidavit for Ractopamine use at check in.***
- ❖ ***All Poultry** projects need to turn in NPIP Hatchery papers at check in.*
- ❖ *Purchase exhibitors pass by **August 15.** Jr Fair pass is \$5.00 but if also showing in Sr Fair Open class you will need an Open Class Pass for \$15.00 instead. If you are in more than one organization, you still only need to purchase one pass.*

- ❖ Complete Quality Assurance by **July 15** if you are taking a Market animal. (See QA paper for dates)
- ❖ Pick up Fair Pass Friday, Sept. 6, Saturday, Sept. 7, or Sunday Sept. 8. **You will need your pass to enter the fair on Monday.**
- ❖ Move in Day is on Sunday! Projects/Animals need to be in place and checked in by **7:00 pm Sunday, September 8th**. Animals may not be brought to the Fairgrounds before 8:00 am Sunday. Scales are open **2:00 pm to 7:00 pm Sunday**.
- ❖ Premium monies for exhibiting at the Fair will be available **at the Jr. Fair Office the day after your show is completed. Hours will be posted at Jr. Fair Office.**
 - ❖ Release day is **Sunday September 15.**
