ALL Species applicants must:

- 1. Must be a Wyandot County Jr Fair participant
- 2. Must have exhibited the species **FOR ONE YEAR PRIOR AND CURRENT YEAR** of application
- 3. Must be enrolled in your species project in 4-H or FFA and a Junior Fair member in good standing
- 4. Each applicant will receive notice of interview date and time
- 5. Previous royalty in respective species is NOT eligible to participate
- 6. May only represent one species in any one year
- 7. Must wear appropriate interview attire
- 8. May not serve as royalty in another county at the same time you are reigning as species royalty in Wyandot County.

Species Specific Rules:

Beef

- Single Female or Male age 14 to 20 as of January 1 of current year is eligible.
- Last year's county or state winner is not eligible this year, but may enter future contests if they
 meet requirements

Swine

- At least 14 years of age as of January 1 of current year
- Must be interested in promoting the pork industry county and statewide.

Lamb and Wool

- Single female age 15-21 inclusive as of January 1 of current year is eligible
- Previous winners of the state contest are not eligible. Other previous winners are eligible as long as they meet the other requirements.

Rabbit, Goat, Dairy & Poultry

At least 13 years of age as of January 1 of current year

Horse

- King/Queen: Horse Project member in good standing age 14 or older as of January 1 of current year.
- Prince/Princess: Horse Project member in good standing age 13 and under as of January 1 of current year.
- Must be enrolled in a horse project FOR ONE YEAR PRIOR AND CURRENT YEAR of application
- Crowning will take place at the Jr. Fair Horse Show- Winner must be present for crowning
