

## Dairy Exhibit

### Livestock Birth Dates, Possession Dates, and Jr. Fair Classes for the 2023 Wyandot County Fair

- Interview judging will be at the discretion of the Ohio State University Extension Office.
- The premium an exhibitor receives will be based on the grade the animal receives in the show ring.

#### Exhibiting at the Fair

- Drug Use Notification Forms must be completed and turned in at check-in on Sunday, September 11.
- Stall space is not to be used to store hay, straw, feed, or supplies.
- Cows in milk can go home after the show *except* the Champion of Champion, which must remain for the week.
- The Dairy show will be held **Monday, September 11 at 10:00 am.**

#### Dairy Department Dress Code

**This is a requirement for show and sale:** Exhibitors must wear a **white full button-up shirt** (no polos), to be buttoned from bottom to at least two buttons from the collar and tucked in. Exhibitors must also wear **white pants/jeans** with no holes. Exhibitors will not be permitted to enter the show/sale ring without wearing appropriate attire.

#### Junior Fair Classes

- **011** Junior Heifer Calf (born after March 1, 2023, or over 4 months old)
- **012** Intermediate Heifer Calf (born after December 1, 2022, and before March 1, 2023)
- **013** Senior Heifer Calf (born after September 1, 2022, and before December 1, 2022)
- **014** Summer Yearling Heifer (born after June 1, 2022, and before September 1, 2022)
- **015** Junior Yearling Heifer (born after March 1, 2022, and before June 1, 2022)
- **016** Intermediate Yearling Heifer (born after December 1, 2021, and before March 1, 2022)
- **017** Senior Yearling Heifer (born after September 1, 2021, and before December 1, 2021)
- **018** Cow over 2 years old and under 3 years old
- **019** Cow 3 years old and over

#### Showmanship Classes

- **Junior** (ages 8-13)
- **Senior** (ages 14-18)
