## Wyandot County Equine Royalty Requirements

### All applicants

- Must be 4-H age 14 or older as of January 1 of the current year
- Must be a Wyandot County 4-H or FFA member in good standing and enrolled in a horse project.
- Must have been enrolled in a 4-H or FFA horse project and exhibited horses in Wyandot County **for one year prior to** as well as current year of application.
- Must participate (show or work) at a Wyandot county PAS or open horse show in 2016.
- Must wear appropriate interview attire.
- May not serve as royalty in another county at the same time as serving Wyandot County as equine royalty.
- Complete application and return to the OSU Extension office by August 15.
- Crowning will take place at the Jr. Fair Horse Show—winner must be present for crowning.

## Wyandot County Equine Royalty Selection Criteria

Royalty will be selected on the basis of:

- **40% Equine program participation: 1 point per year as 4-H or FFA membership and 1 point per completed project. (Beginning Horse Management taken for 3 years counts as only one project)**
- **35% Leadership in 4-H, FFA and Jr. Fair: 1 point per 4-H club or FFA chapter officer position; 2 points each serving Wyandot County as Jr. Fairboard member or Jr. Fair Assistant, youth member of 4-H Advisory Council, 4-H Endowment Committee, 4-H Horse Committee; 1 point per officer position held on Wyandot County Jr. Fairboard.**
- **15% Community Service: 1 point per individual Community Service activity**
  
- **10% (Tie Breaker): Essay**
